Key Vocabulary:	
Cut	Make an opening or incision with a sharp edged tool.
Roll	Move in a particular direction by turning over and over on an axis.
Smooth	Having an even and regular surface.
Flatten	Make or become flat or flatter.
Shape	Give a particular shape or form too.
3D	Three dimensional
Casting	The making of an object
Sculpture	Make or represent (a form) by carving, casting or other shaping techniques.
Impressing	Make a mark or design on an object
Surface	The outside part or uppermost layer of something.
Score	A notch or line cut or scratched into a surface.
Slip	A liquid mixture of clay and water.
