

Fish	An animal that lives in water, has fins for	
	swimming, and gills for breathing.	
Amphibian	A cold-blooded animal that spends some	
	time on land and in water.	
Reptile	A cold-blooded animal that usually has	
	the skin covered with scales or bony	
	plates.	
Mammal	A warm-blooded animal with a skeleton	
	inside its body that grows hair or fur on	
	its skin; mammal mothers produce milk to	
	feed their babies.	
Bird	An animal with a backbone that has	
	feathers, wings and a beak.	
Warm-blooded	Having a warm body temperature that	
	does not change with the temperature of	
	the air.	
Cold-blooded	Having a body temperature that changes	
	with the temperature of the air or water.	
Herbivore	An animal that only eats plants.	
Carnivore	An animal that eats meat.	
Omnivore	An animal that eats meat and plants.
