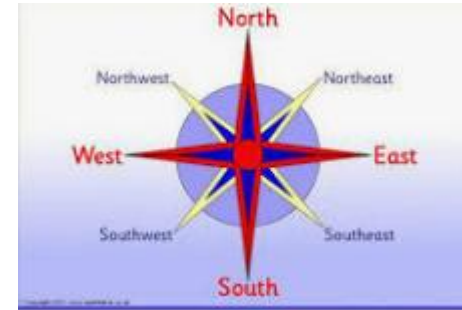
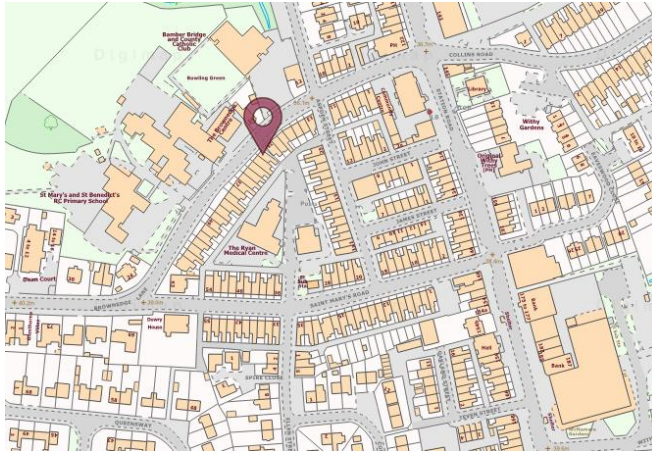

### Map Symbols

To make it easier for us to read, maps use symbols instead of words so that we can find things faster. Here are some symbols that you might be able to recognise:

### Key Vocabulary:

<b>Map</b>	A specially drawn picture of a place from above.
<b>Symbol</b>	A picture that represents a word or group of words. They are used on maps to make things clear and easy to find.
<b>Physical feature</b>	A feature that is built or put there by people.
<b>Human feature</b>	A feature that occurs in nature (not put there by people)
<b>Direction</b>	Where someone or something is pointing or moving.
<b>Fieldwork</b>	Using maps to go out and about to get a practical understanding of something.
